

The Cross of St Piran Award

Kevin Grant has been awarded the Cross of St Piran and it will be presented to him by Bishop Chris Goldsmith at a special service in St Piran's Church, Perranzabuloe on Sunday 5 March 2017 at 3.30pm.

This award was instituted by the Bishop of Truro in 2011 to recognise the outstanding service given by lay people in the Diocese.



Kevin was nominated for this award by Revd Philp Sharp, the Rural Dean of West Wilvershire. Telling Kevin of the news, Bishop Chris Goldsmith writes, *"I am told that you have devoted yourself to witnessing the Gospel through word and deed. As a postman in Liskeard you were always a positive ambassador for the Kingdom, and as a chaplain to the Liskeard Royal British Legion offering Christian hope to a wide diversity of people. As a local worship leader and member of St Martin's choir you have served the local Anglican Church for many years and as a Roman Catholic have positively bridged the ecumenical divide to witness to our Christian need to work together as one body."*
