“I have not had a sudden, or dramatic conversion, like many people seem to, but have experienced a steady and continually growing faith over the years. My father was a Methodist minister and so going to church and being a member of the Christian community has been part of my life since I was born.

From a child it was the normal thing to do, as was becoming confirmed as a teenager. I don't feel I really started my Christian journey until I went to METHSOC (the student Methodist group) when I was at college in Brighton.
